## HOW DO I PROTECT MY COMPUTER?

### Update your software

1. If you have a computer support coordinator (CSC), no action on your part is required.
2. If you do not have a CSC or they do not support your computer, refer to Microsoft Security Bulletin Summary for September 2013 <sup>[1]</sup> on how to obtain the latest updates for your specific software.
