WHAT'S THE PROBLEM?

If any of the vulnerabilities are exploited, this could allow an attacker to take control of your computer or disclose information.

HOW DO I PROTECT MY COMPUTER?

Update your software

1. If you have a computer support coordinator (CSC), no action on your part is required.
2. If you do not have a CSC or they do not support your computer, refer to Microsoft Security Bulletin Summary for August 2013 ^[1] on how to obtain the latest updates for your specific software.
