- macOS Sierra 10.12.3 for macOS Sierra 10.12.2
- iOS 10.2.1 for iPhone 5 and later, iPad 4th generation and later, iPod touch 6th generation and later
- tvOS 10.1.1 for Apple TV (4th generation)
- watchOS 3.1.3 for all Apple Watch Models

## WHAT'S THE PROBLEM?

Exploitation of some of these vulnerabilities may allow a remote attacker to take control of an affected system.
