

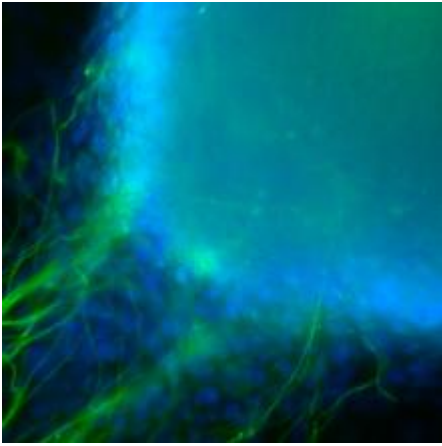

UCSF has Minimum Security Standards ^[1] for all computing resources. By following these standards, all devices will meet UCSF's Information Security & Confidentiality Policy ^[2].

These standards include recommendations for:

- Anti-Virus Software ^[3] (including personal firewall software)
- Email ^[4]
- Encryption ^[5] of any laptop or mobile devices
- Passwords ^[6]
- Physical Security ^[7] (i.e. anti-theft)
- Keeping software up to date
