UCSF ITS/Medical Center IT Computing Related Listservs

These listservs are used by the Campus and Medical Center IT groups to communicate important IT-related messages to the UCSF community. Subscription to these listservs is self-managed via the Listserv Account Registration form found at the ITS Help site ^[1]. Archive information for each listserv is noted below.

- **NETWORK-UPDATE**(Campus Network Notices)

- **UCSF-ITS-INFO (replaces OAAIS-INFO)** (General UCSF ITS Notices)
 - UCSF ITS announcements, emergency outages & IT related info. Archived ^[4] from 4 February 2011.
- **OAAIS-INFO (replaced by UCSF-ITS-INFO)**(General UCSF ITS Notices)
 - UCSF ITS announcements, emergency outages & IT related info. Archived ^[4] from 5 May 2008 to 4 February 2011.
- **ITSERVICEALERTS**(IT Service Alerts)

- A weekly digest of scheduled maintenance operations
- **SECURITY-UPDATE**(Campus IT Security Notices)
 - Campus IT security updates and information. Archived ^[5] from 14 May 2008.

Computing Related Discussion Listservs

These listservs are used to promote peer-to-peer discussions. To subscribe to one of these lists, send email to listserv@listsrv.ucsf.edu ^[6], leave the subject line blank and make the first line of the mail read **Subscribe listname your_full_name** (Example: Subscribe IT-FORUM John Doe). Archive information for each listserv is noted below.

- **ADMIN-L**(No Longer Available. This lists was decommissioned in August 2008 and split into four listservs: IT-FORUM, NETWORK-UPDATE, OAAIS-INFO and SECURITY-UPDATE)
 - Archives from 2 February 1997 through 1 February 2008 are posted here ^[7].
 - Archives from 1 February 2008 through 1 August 2008 are posted here. ^[8]
- **IT-FORUM**(UCSF IT-Related Questions and Discussions)
 - An open forum for UCSF employees to have IT-related conversations and to post IT-related news or questions.
 - Campus-wide peer-to-peer IT discussion. Archived ^[9] from 7 May 2008
- **MACOSX-L**(Mac OS X Discussion)
 - Discussion of problems and solutions for Mac OS X users at UCSF. Archived ^[10] from 15 March 2002.
- **NIX-L**(Linux and Unix Discussion)
 - Discussion of problems and solutions for Linux and UNIX users and system administrators. Archived ^[11] from 21 September 2007.
- **PROGRAMMING**(Discussion List for Programmers)
 - Share/Leverage programming expertise across the UCSF. Archived ^[12] from 8 Dec 2008.
- **WEBMASTR**(UCSF Website Owners)
 - Staff handling development/maintenance of UCSF websites. Archived ^[13] from 5 March 2001.
